Dear Mr. Cho:

Parsons is transmitting the remedial system monthly summary report for August 2010 for the DFSP Norwalk Facility in Norwalk, California. Both the groundwater treatment system (GWTS) and soil vapor extraction system (SVES) were inoperable during this reporting period as explained below.

The GWTS was shutdown following selenium limit exceedance and remained down for confirmation of selenium results and exploration of remedial options to mitigate selenium exceedance. Last week and this week, we have received the results of the selenium analysis from three independent laboratories and all three results have come back non-detect with a reporting limit of 1 µg/L at two laboratories and 2 µg/L at the third laboratory. Therefore, the system commenced operation on September 7th and has operated continuous since then. Selenium samples will be collected weekly and sent to the laboratory for analysis. Should there be a substantial increase in selenium, then a split sample will be collected to be sent to a second and third laboratory for confirmation.

SVES redesign is in progress and will include the procurement and installation of a bigger blower and increased pipe sizes to facilitate greater flows from across the site. Pending completion of SVES redesign and equipment installation the SVES will resume operation.
