Dear Mr. Bole:


On October 14, 2014, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) received the technical document titled *Workplan for Well Abandonment* (Workplan), prepared by The Source Group, Inc., on your behalf, for the above referenced site (Site). The Workplan proposes to remove a total of 44 wells as they are located within the soil excavation footprints throughout the Site, including 17 groundwater monitoring wells, 16 vapor extraction wells, 9 inactive sparging wells, 1 groundwater extraction well, and 1 groundwater gauge well.

We have reviewed the Workplan and have the following comments:

1. Provide well construction and lithological data for each well to be abandoned.
2. Discuss the proposed abandonment method complies with requirement prescribed in California Well Standards (Bulletin 74-90), published by the California Department of Water Resources (can be viewed at http://www.dpla.water.ca.gov/sd/groundwater/california_well_standards/well_standards.html).
3. It is stated in the Workplan that a separate plan for well replacement will be submitted prior to installation of the replacement well. Specify wells to be replaced and provide a schedule when the well replacement workplan will be submitted.
