Dear Dr. Yang:

The Waste Discharge Requirements issued on February 6, 2015 for soil treatment at the Defense Fuel Support Point Norwalk located at 15306 Norwalk Boulevard, Norwalk, California, (the Site) included a 365-day time limit provision.

The soil treatment at the Site has required an extension of that time limit to complete the project. As reported to the RWQCB in quarterly WDR reports and multiple soil treatment progress reports, excavation started on March 17, 2015, and most of the shallow contaminated soil at the Site has been treated, but some additional soil remains to be treated.

Therefore the Defense Logistics Agency – Energy (DLA – Energy) is requesting a one-year extension to the operations under the WDR for the Site. As I discussed with you today, due to an administrative oversight, the submittal of this request was delayed. All sampling and reporting requirements listed in the WDR have been complied with, and SGI will continue to report on the progress sampling and post-remediation sampling as required by the WDR.
