Subject: Bi-monthly Update on Property Access, South-Central and Southeastern Off-Site Areas, Defense Fuel Support Point Norwalk, 15306 Norwalk Boulevard, Norwalk, CA

Dear Mr. Cho:

Pursuant to your request made in a letter dated August 11, 2010, CH2M HILL is submitting this letter on behalf of SFPP, L.P. (SFPP), an operating partnership of Kinder Morgan Energy Partners, L.P. (KMEP), to provide an update on the progress made to obtain property access for a soil vapor monitoring program in off-site areas south and east of the Defense Fuel Support Point - Norwalk located at 15306 Norwalk Boulevard in Norwalk, California (DFSP; the site). The soil vapor monitoring program was requested by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (RWQCB) in its letter dated March 30, 2010. A work plan for installing a soil vapor monitoring network (the work plan) was submitted to the RWQCB on May 27, 2010 and approved on August 11, 2010.

As described in the work plan and SFPP's previous correspondence with the RWQCB, SFPP will obtain written authorization to access the necessary properties. In preparation for obtaining written authorization to access the necessary private properties, a Right of Entry Permit was prepared and provided as Attachment B of the work plan. SFPP has made initial contact with private property owners in the south-central off-site area to inform them that the Right of Entry Permit would be mailed to them in the coming weeks. SFPP will distribute the Right of Entry Permits after its legal department provides final approval.

SFPP is currently working with the City of Norwalk to finalize a temporary site access agreement to allow SFPP to install and monitor a soil vapor monitoring probe in the southwest corner of Holifield Park (southeastern off-site area). The access agreement is expected to be finalized in November 2010.
