Subject: Extension Request for Shallow Soil Closure Report and Human Health Risk Assessment, SFPP Norwalk Pump Station, Norwalk, California

Dear Mr. Cho:

This letter has been prepared in response to your March 25 and April 12, 2016 letters to SFPP, L.P. (SFPP) requesting a shallow soil closure report and human health risk assessment for the eastern 15-acre parcel of the Defense Fuel Support Point Norwalk, located at 15306 Norwalk Boulevard, Norwalk, California. In the letters, you requested that SFPP submit the shallow soil closure report by May 15, 2016 and the human health risk assessment by May 31, 2016.

As requested by the Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (RWQCB), SFPP recently performed additional soil sampling at five locations, and installed and sampled three dual nested soil gas probes in the 15-acre parcel to support shallow soil closure in this area. The field investigation was completed by SFPP on May 9, 2016. The laboratory analytical reports for soil and soil gas samples will not be available for an additional two to three weeks. Once received, SFPP will process the data and complete the human health risk assessment and shallow soil closure report. To accommodate the RWQCB's request for additional soil and soil gas data collection, SFPP requests an extension for submittal of this report to June 30, 2016.
