3	Project Update (N. Irish)				
	Mr. Irish discussed the results of the most recent groundwater sampling. One particular well had a slight increase, while another had a dramatic decrease. He said the TPH plume is virtually the same since last check.				
	Ms. Anderson requested a map for each plume. Mr. Irish will reduce each map and send out to the RAB members when the final report is issued.	Neil Irish	When report is final.		
	Mr. Miller asked about groundwater. Mr. Irish said it moves 30 feet a year. Mr. Irish talked about TPH, BTEX, and 1,2-DCA. Ms. Anderson asked if the groundwater flows 30ft/yr, why don't the chemicals move that much also? Mr. Irish replied because of the "retardation factor" and the difference in chemical compounds. Mr. Fogle asked about rain runoff. Mr. Rifilato said it goes into the oil/water separator with clean, treated effluent ending up in Coyote Creek.				
	Mr. Whitaker suggested a chronology and brief summary of events regarding the Tank Farm might be helpful. Lt. Col. Gross agreed, saying this could be a workshop topic.
