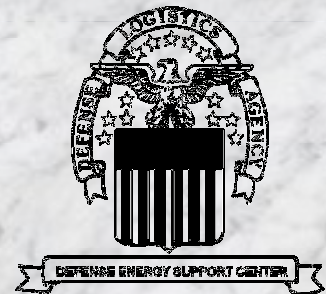

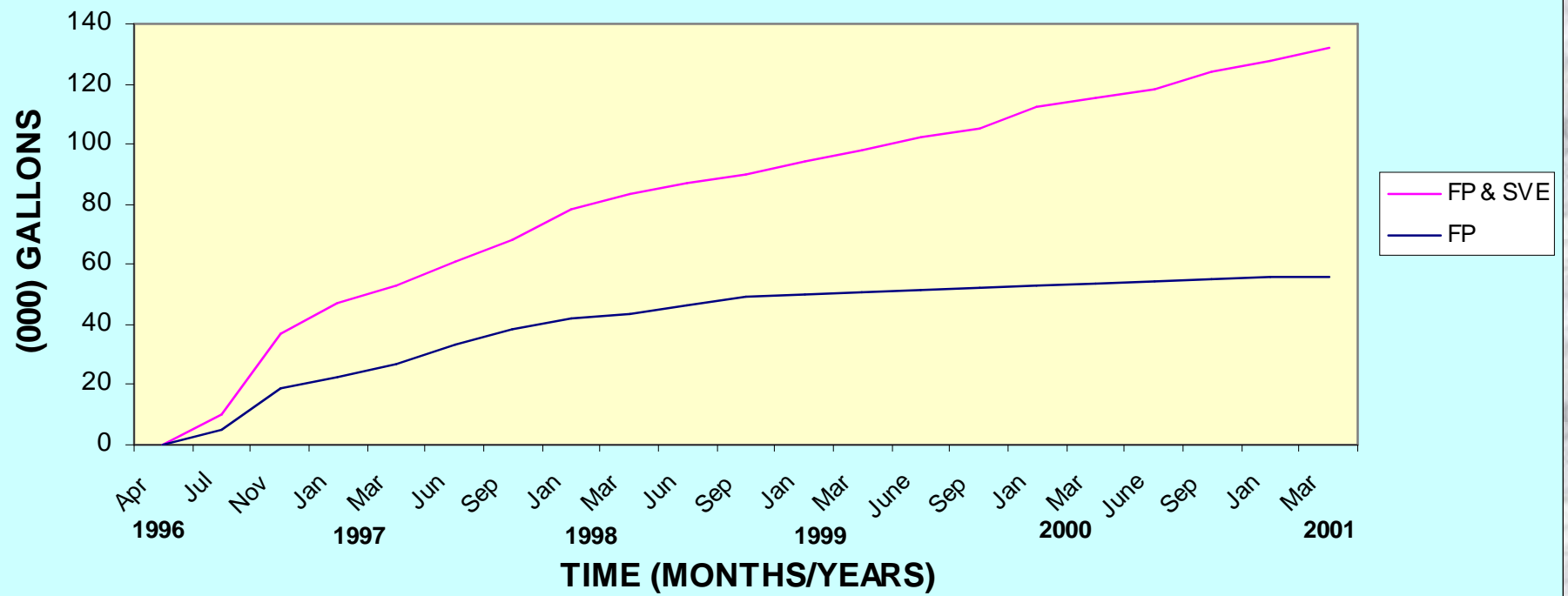
# 3 Wells Sampled March 2001

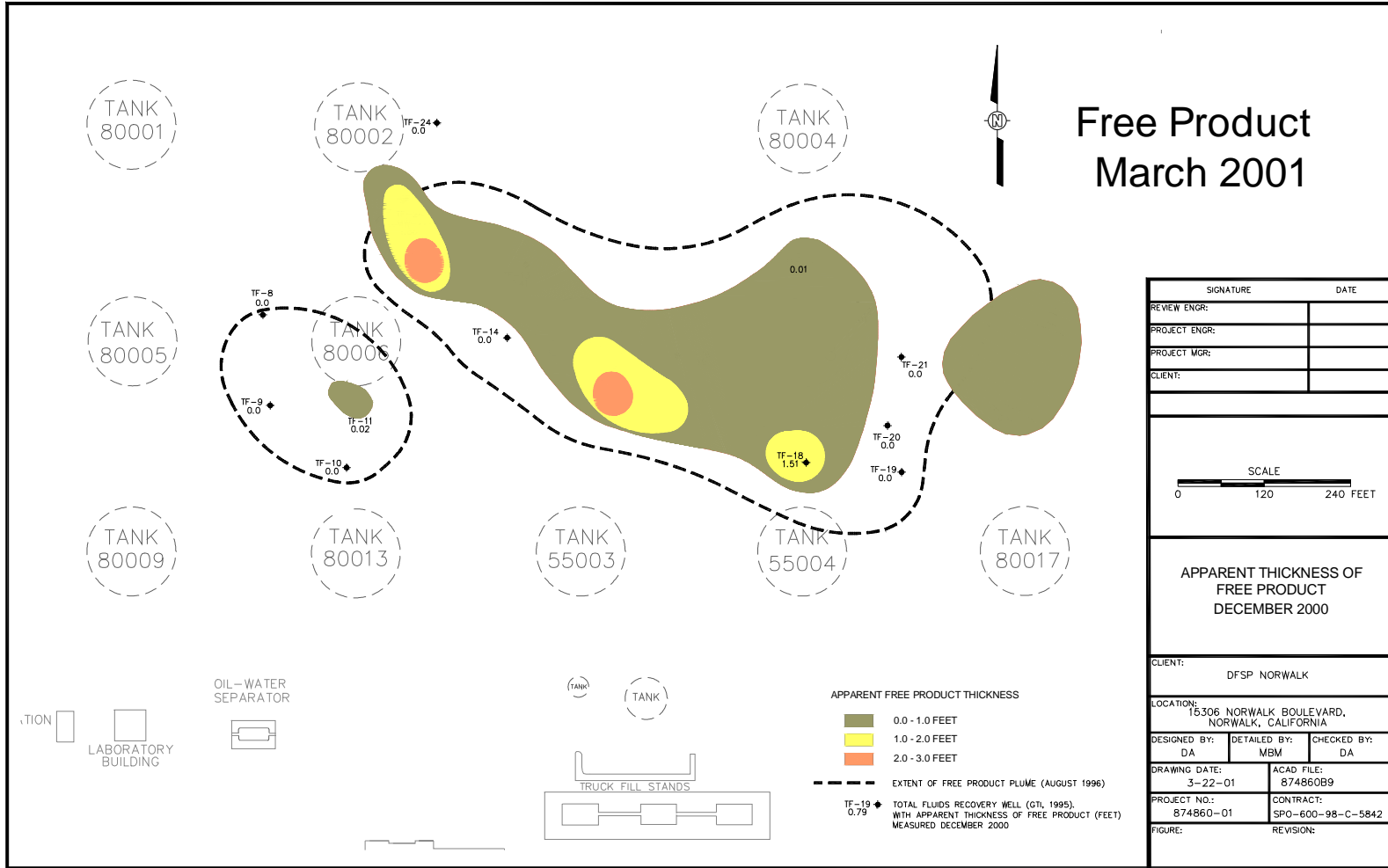
- MW-13, GMW-47, and GMW-57
- GMW-58 was gauged and showed free product (this well not sampled)
- Wells MW-13, and GMW-47 showed Non-detect for TPH as Fuel Product (site standard)
- GMW-57 showed TPH as Fuel Product (site standard) at 1,800 ppb
- All wells with free product are gauged biweekly
- Alternately wells GMW-57, GMW-58, GMW-59 are under remediation with the product recovery trailer

# Central Plume Remediation

- System performance since April 1996
  - Approx. 133,515 gallons recovered and recycled
    - 55,653 gallons of free product recovered
    - 76,551 gallons of volatile hydrocarbons recovered through soil vapor extraction
  - 30M gallons of water treated
  - 1,311 gallons of dissolved phase hydrocarbons recovered
