


Discussion of 1,2 DCA Subcommittee & General Progress Update

Presented to Norwalk Restoration Advisory Board July 25, 1996




- ◆ Candidates were: Gene Garcia, Laurie Smith & William Miller

- ◆ They will represent the RAB/Community on the DCA Subcommittee




- ◆ SFPP & DFOLA still working on academia selection
- ◆ Questionnaire prepared for academia candidates-draft copy for your review
- ◆ We believe this will provide more insight to their experience & will aid the RAB in the selection process
- We are looking at 7 candidates (incl. 1 RAB Submission)
- ◆ Will incorporate any RAB suggestions into questionnaire & send to candidates (7/31/96)

Academia Selection


- ◆ Candidates reply back by 8/8/96
- ◆ WCFS to collate ballot with candidates resumes' & questionnaires, mail to RAB by 8/12/96
- ◆ RAB response by mail by 8/22/96
- ◆ Confirmation mailing to RAB of academia selection by 8/27/96
- ◆ First DCA subcommittee meeting on 9/19/96 (orig. scheduled date)



- ◆ Groundwater Monitoring-First event for 1996 completed
- ◆ Preliminary MTBE results collated at RAB request
- ♦ of 43 wells tested, 13 had MTBE detected.
- ◆ Summary table provided in handouts



- ◆ South Central Plume Cleanup-Increased liquids pumping rate significantly
- ◆ How- At request of RAB member, have been watching the well flow rates, tested a new style of pump in well GMW-9
- ◆ New pumping setup pumps faster. Will change remaining 5 pumps in SC plume in August. Expect to



◆ System has operated 3900 hours since startup

Vapor Extraction System Summary


- ◆ Approximately 80,000 gallons of fuel removed from soil and destroyed
- ◆ Approximately 15,000 gallons of fuel removed since 4/25/96 RAB meeting




Free Product Recovery System Summary


- ◆ Approximately 430,000 gallons of water pumped and treated
- ◆ Approximately 4,600 gallons of liquid fuel recovered
- ◆ Approximately 1,900 gallons of liquid fuel recovered since 4/25/96 RAB meeting
- ◆ New pump installed in well GMW-9 in May for trial, flow increased 3 times.

 Similar pumps to be installed in remaining wells in August














Summary of Liquid Phase Extraction Operations





Summary of liquid Phase Pumping Rates






- ◆ Wells installed, testing complete

- ◆ On schedule for bidding out construction


JD Chang Property Access Update

- ◆ Submitted detailed response to City in regard to permit condition issues on behalf of JD Chang
- ◆ Meeting Scheduled with City on August 8.
- ◆ We hope to get building permit approved, so JD Chang will give us access to property to install additional recovery wells



Summary of Free Product Measurements





- ◆ Sparge wells installed on schedule
- ◆ Testing underway to see if sparging effective for dissolved phase cleanup
- ◆ Preparing bid specifications for cleanup system installation-on schedule



Noise Testing Update

- ◆ Completed monitoring on Bob Hoskins property
- ◆ Interpreting results & designing noise abatement for mainline pumps
- ◆ Got internal approval to put sound jacketing on Golden West valve. will be completed by mid-August, 1996
