SUBJECT: REVIEW OF PHASE 1 EXCAVATIONS AND STOCKPILES SAMPLING REPORTS

CASE/SITE: DEFENSE FUEL SUPPORT POINT NORWALK, 15306 NORWALK BOULEVARD, NORWALK, CALIFORNIA (SCP NO. 0286A, SITE ID NO. 16638)

Dear Mr. Carros:

On July 15, 2015, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) received a technical document titled *Phase 1 Excavations and Stockpiles Sampling Reports and Request for Authorization to Backfill* (Report), prepared by The Source Group, Inc. (SGI), on behalf of Defense Logistics Agency (DLA), for the above referenced site (Site). This Report proposes to backfill the Phase 1 excavations using the Phase 1 untreated clean soil stockpiles as a first step towards the Site's redevelopment, according to the following technical documents prepared by SGI:

- *Revised Soil Management Plan: Treatment Cell Operation and Site Excavation*, dated November 5, 2014
- *Soil Remedial Action Plan*, dated November 30, 2014
- *Addendum to Soil Remedial Action Plan*, dated December 10, 2014

The excavation of areas of hydrocarbon contaminated soil for onsite soil treatment resulted in the removal of overburden soil that was confirmed in the field to be non-contaminated. The removed overburden soil was then stockpiled at the Site. On January 7, 2015, Regional Board requested that analytical results should be submitted for each untreated clean soil stockpile before reuse. The Report presents confirmation soil sampling results for the following untreated clean soil stockpiles:

Stockpiles	Volume (cubic yards)
CS 1	933
CS 2A	900
CS 10	600
CS 12	4,550
CS 14	2,460

Based on the confirmation soil sampling results of the Phase 1 untreated clean soil stockpiles (CS 1, CS 2A, CS 10, CS 12, and CS 14), concentrations of hydrocarbons and volatile organic compounds are below the Site's soil cleanup goals. We have no objection to the proposed backfilling of Phase 1 excavations using the untreated clean soil stockpiles CS 1, CS 2A, CS 10, CS 12, and CS 14.
