### ***SUMMARY OF REMEDIATION PROGRESS***

Remediation systems at the Site include a groundwater extraction and treatment system (GWETS), soil vapor extraction systems, biosparge system, and a product removal system. The treatment of extracted soil vapors and groundwater at the Site has been conducted to address historical impacts within the entire former tank farm, former water tank, former truck fueling, and pump house areas.


The GWETS consists of five vertical extraction wells (four 6-inch diameter wells and one 4-inch diameter well), three bag filter vessels, two MYCELX oil separator vessels, three granular activated carbon (GAC) vessels, and two ion exchange vessels. No groundwater extraction wells were in operation this period. The non-discharge of any treated groundwater during Quarter 3, 2019 is being reported to comply with Section IX, Part A.2 of the Monitoring and Reporting Program (MRP).
